The Program is self-managed by a Board of Directors. They volunteer their services and meet once a month to review upcoming trips, luncheons, as well as, a monthly Lunch and Learn for all members who are interested in attending. A bus is provided for trips so you can sit back and relax. DOH is in operation from March through December.
